building on faith

Tacoma/Pierce County Habitat for Humanity designates one home each year as the **Building on Faith** house, inviting faith groups from all backgrounds to put their faith into action helping to build a home for a family in need.

The 2025 Building on Faith house is at our Proctor Place neighborhood in south Tacoma. Construction began in summer 2025. The home is scheduled to finish in early 2026.

The **2026 Building on Faith** home should begin construction in spring/summer 2026.

wall of hope

The first wall raised in each Building on Faith home is the **Wall of Hope**. Faith groups who give \$750+ annually are invited to:

- Keep a 2×6 Wall of Hope stud at their place of worship so members may write messages of hope and blessings to the family who will live in the Building on Faith house
- Participate in the Wall of Hope wall raising
- Join the celebration and meet the family when the Building on Faith home is dedicated

build site opportunities

Everyone is welcome to join us in Building on Faith.

Individuals new to Habitat should attend a 30-minute virtual New Volunteer Orientation prior to coming out.

Groups wishing to volunteer together must reserve a date in advance.

Faith organizations giving \$1,000+ annually may reserve one day for up to 10 individuals for every \$1,000 donated and may reserve dates up to 9 months in advance.

No donation is required to schedule a group of 5 or fewer.
